## TRUST BASED RELATIONAL INTERVENTION

Trust Based Relational Intervention (TBRI) is a holistic intervention that meets the needs of the whole child. It is an approach to caregiving that is developmentally respectful, responsive to trauma and attachment-based. The three principles of TBRI are Connecting, Empowering and Correcting.
